Please note that conference sections as primary thematic areas, while noting that submissions are not limited to these topics.

Requirements to the materials submitted to the conference:

Conference materials should be in electronic form in MS Word-2003, 2007 (DOC, DOCX) format, font Times New Roman 14, paragraph 1 cm, line spacing 1, pages should be 2 cm on all sides. The volume of the material (together with tables, figures, drawings and Internet resources) of the article should be not less than 8 pages, the thesis - 3 pages.

Conference proceedings should comply with **IMRAD** requirements: title of



the topic, information about the authors, abstract, keywords, introduction, literature review on the topic, materials and methods, analysis and results, conclusions and proposals, list of references.

In the first line in the middle in capital and bold letters is written the title of the article, in the second line on the right side of the page-family name, first name and patronymic of the author, in the third line on the right side of the page-place of work, position, academic degree and title of the author.

All tables, diagrams and pictures should be in MS Word format with Times New Roman font, their name should be under the diagram and pictures, and the number and name of tables above the tables;

- charts and diagrams should be in MS Excel format;
- formulas should be written in MS Equation;
- tables, figures and graphs should include sources and references to them in the text;
- references should be placed at the bottom of each page.

Articles and abstracts are checked by anti-plagiarism program. Conference materials are accepted in English. Participation at the conference.

At the end of the plenary session conclusions and proposals are discussed and final recommendations are adopted. The Organizing Committee has the right to select abstracts and articles.

Only scientific articles and thesis of the authors who have been edited and recommended for publication will be published, the author(s) will be provided with a package of conference materials in electronic (pdf) version.

Scientific articles and thesis that fail to meet the established requirements will not be accepted for publication and will not be returned to the authors.
